


# Prostate treatment at Gateway

The treatment is painless and performed by a professional care giver.

What you should consider in advance is that you have visited the toilet. Of course, you can visit the toilet and take shower at our local.

A shorter walk-through with the care giver will be held, so you feel yourself more comfortable (of course you're a bit worried the first time) and that you're in safe hands.



Since the problem itself has not occurred overnight, it will most likely take 1-5 treatments for to see and feel the effect.

After a few treatments, the pee requirement will decrease, and that urine can flow faster (the bladder feels "emptier").


An anesthetic ointment can (or will) be used because the ring muscle can be a bit sensitive and "thwart" the treatment itself.

You'll probably feel tired during and after treatment.

Some clients feel the need to visit the toilet after treatment and it is perfectly normal.

The actual execution is done with a stave that is a little bit thicker than your index finger. It is inserted approx. 3-6cm into the anal opening.

The stave emits heat (app 40-42C°), it vibrates with 0.1-0.2mm sideways with a variable frequency of 18-90Hz and in addition, it will emit variable magnetism with a strength of 0.5-4mT.



We cover the stave with a condom and oil so the stave can be more easily be inserted into the anal opening. The nurse will be audible with your reactions. It is perfectly normal that in most cases the client feels uncomfortable with a rod in the anal and that it is performed by an outsider. Therefore, one has a walkthrough before so that both feel safe for the procedure that takes about 45 minutes (lying on a treatment table).

These details together will affect the collected liquid in the prostate, which in turn prevents the normal blood circulation in the prostate.
